This (enter as appropriate) notes the important contribution that renewable energy co-operatives can make to the transition away from fossil fuels, by creating a source of affordable, community controlled energy, and resolves that measures should be taken to ensure the further development of these projects by ensuring that:

1. National legislation specifically supports a whole range of citizen ownership and participation in the production and/or use of sustainable energy, including setting planning expectations
2. National targets are established for renewable energy, and specifically for community power.
3. Community power projects are not subject to competitive bidding processes, and are instead eligible for feed in tariffs
4. Governments at all level provide financial support for preliminary investigations and works on community power projects
