Renewable Energy

This (enter as appropriate) notes the important contribution that renewable energy co-operatives can make to the transition away from fossil fuels, by creating a source of affordable, community controlled energy, and resolves that measures should be taken to ensure the further development of these projects by ensuring that:

- 1. National legislation specifically supports a whole range of citizen ownership and participation in the production and/or use of sustainable energy, including setting planning expectations
- 2. National targets are established for renewable energy, and specifically for community power.
- 3. Community power projects are not subject to competitive bidding processes, and are instead eligible for feed in tariffs
- 4. Governments at all level provide financial support for preliminary investigations and works on community power projects
